Regarding the RCC roof in the 3rd floor which is marked as lift machine room, the same has already been covered in the CMDA refused plan dt.2.6.1999 which is an evidence to prove that the structure in the terrace floor is constructed prior to 28.2.1999. As the applicant has complied with the direction of the Monitoring Committee, it was resolved to regularise the construction subject to payment of balance Reg fees and other applicable charges.

Minutes The Monitoring Committee discussed the subject in detail and noticed that the applicant has complied with the direction of the 46th Monitoring Committee meeting held on 12.09.2012. In compliance of the Monitoring Committee’s decision, the applicant has remitted the balance property tax arrears from II/1998-99 till date. Hence, the Committee resolved to regularise the construction subject to remittance of balance Reg fees and other applicable charges.

Hence, the Monitoring Committee decided to accept the working sheet as evidence of having completed the individual flat prior to 28.2.1999 and resolved to regularise the same subject to remittance of necessary fees and charges.

Minutes The Monitoring Committee discussed the subject in detail and observed that the applicant has furnished a copy of CMDA Stop Work Notice dt.6.12.1993, copy of CMDA Demolition Notice dt.25.7.1994 and copy of the sketch from the Enforcement Cell file as proof of having completed the construction prior to 28.2.1999. The Committee also noted that the 3rd floor constructed after the cut of date has been removed as per the recordings available in the file. Accordingly, the Committee accepted the Stop Work and Demolition Notices issued by Enforcement Cell of CMDA as evidence of having completed the building prior to 28.2.1999 and resolved to regularise the buildings subject to remittance of balance Reg. fee and necessary charges and removal of small temporary additional structures constructed within the site.

Minutes The Committee discussed the subject in detail. In the 44th Monitoring Committee meeting held on 30.03.2012, the Committee desired that the site may be re-inspected to ascertain the present stage. Accordingly, the site was re-inspected on 14.5.2013 and recorded that there is an existing G+3 floors building and no additional construction done after the inspection dt.4.1.2002. The Revenue Officer, Chennai Corporation has furnished the statement of floor wise revised property tax details dt.8.3.2012 with effect from II/1998-99 and it was resolved to accept the same as evidence of having completed the building prior to 28.2.1999. The Revenue Officers of Corporation of Chennai present during the meeting also confirmed that the property tax revision statement furnished is genuine. Accordingly, the Monitoring Committee resolved to regularise the building subject to remittance of balance Reg. fee and other applicable charges.

Minutes The Committee discussed the subject in detail and noticed that the applicant has furnished Corporation of Chennai property tax working sheet showing the number of floors and floor area. It is noticed that the built up area of the building as per Reg. plan is 5482.64 sq.ft. whereas the area as per Corporation property tax assessment working sheet is 4420 sq.ft. which is 1062 sq.ft. less than the constructed area. The Committee also observed that there is a temporary shed in the 5th floor. The Committee decided to accept the Corporation of Chennai property tax working sheet as evidence of having completed the building prior to 28.2.1999 and resolved to regularise the building after collecting the balance Reg. fee and other applicable charges subject to the following:

- i) The applicant has to re-assess the building as per the actual constructed area and remit the arrears from II/1998-99 till date.
- ii) To remove the temporary shed in the 5th floor.

The Hon'ble High Court in its order dt.28.11.2012 in W.P.No.31287 of 2012 directed the Government to dispose the appeal as expeditiously as possible. Accordingly the Monitoring Committee decided to inform the Government about the court case and dispose the appeal petition expeditiously.

Minutes The Committee discussed the subject in detail and noticed that the applicant has furnished the assessment particulars furnished by Assistant Revenue Officer Zone XIII Corporation of Chennai in Lr.No.ZO.XIII.R.D.C.No.2246/2012, dt.28.11.2012 showing the assessed area of each floor before II/1998-99. In addition the Monitoring Committee has also noticed that the applicant has furnished extract of Corporation of Chennai Ledger showing the area of the building. The Committee has further observed that the area shown in the

Corporation of Chennai property tax working sheet is less than the actual area constructed. The Committee resolved to accept the evidence produced by the applicant from Corporation of Chennai as credible evidence of having completed the building prior to 28.2.1999 and decided to regularise the same subject to the following:

- i) The applicant has to re-assess the building as per the actual constructed area and remit the arrears till date.
- ii) To remit the balance Reg. fee and other applicable charges.

evidence of having completed the building prior to 28.2.1999 and decided to regularise the individual flat subject to remittance of balance Reg. fee and other applicable charges.
