As per the guidance of the **Hon'ble Chief Minister of Tamil Nadu**, to implement the announcements of CMDA for the financial year 2023-24, Hon'ble Minister for Micro, Small and Medium Enterprises (MS&ME) Thiru. T.M.Anbarasan and Hon'ble Minister cum Chairman for Chennai Metropolitan Development Authority and Minister for Hindu Religious and Charitable Endowments Thiru. P.K. Sekarbabu today (22.5.2023) inspected Chengalpattu District, Mudichur, Chennai Outer Ring Road at a cost of Rs.29 crores in connection with selection of parking place for private omni buses; development of Mudichur, Seekanan lake at a cost of Rs.2 crores; development of Mudichur, Ranga Nagar Pond at a cost of Rs.1.50 Crore; construction of playground and park at Pammal, Eashwari nagar within the limit of Tambaram city corporation at an estimate of 2 crores and the construction of Community Hall at New street, Alandur within the limit of GCC at an estimated cost of Rs.10 crores, they went directly to the places and conducted a field inspections.

## Hon'ble Minister cum Chairman for Chennai Metropolitan Development Authority and Minister for Hindu Religious and Charitable Endowments Thiru.P.K. Sekarbabu said:

As per the guidance of the **Hon'ble Chief Minister of Tamil Nadu**, instructed to go to the field and inspect the announcements of CMDA for the financial year 2023-24, still 28 places were inspected out of 34 projects in the 26 Assembly constituencies, and the remaining 6 places will be inspected at the end of this month and the work will be started by the end of this year.

In these 34 projects, we are undertaking various types of work like beautifying areas under the flyovers, constructing playgrounds, constructing classrooms, constructing marriage halls, developing laundries and developing the Bus terminals. Today (22.05.2023), we have inspected Chengalpattu District, Mudichur, Chennai Outer Ring Road at a cost of Rs.29 crores in connection with selection of parking place for private omni buses; development of Mudichur, Seekanan lake at a cost of Rs.2 crores; development of Mudichur, Ranga Nagar Pond at a cost of Rs.1.50 Crore; construction of playground and park at Pammal, Eashwari Nagar within the limit of Tambaram city corporation at an estimate of 2 crores and the construction of community hall at New street, Alandur within the limit of GCC at an estimated

cost of Rs.10 crores and we are planned to start these 34 works within three months and carrying out continuous inspection. Still 28 places were inspected out of 34 projects in the 26 Assembly constituencies. We are requesting to complete the inspection of the remaining 6 places by the end of this month and speed up all the work to start them. Similarly, today (22.5.2023) a field inspection was carried out the place for Idle Parking to the private Omni Buses at Outer Ring Road at a cost of Rs.29 crores on an area of 5 acres at Mudichur, Chennai.

In the case of Kilambakkam Bus Terminal, in the previous government, it was designed without considering the traffic of buses coming to this terminal. This bus terminal has been designed without taking into account the basic needs of the people while analyzing each and every one of the basic needs of the people when it comes to the use of this bus terminal. Therefore, we have studied and arranged the access of roads to this bus terminal, as well as the planning to deal with the traffic congestion coming to this bus terminal. As now the position is, that it should be inaugurated by the end of this June, we planned to complete the arrangements as much as possible and open the bus terminals by the end of June, or even if it is delayed by a week or two, or the terminal will be ready by the end of July to arrange all the infrastructures to meet the basic needs of the people while the bus terminal is ready for use by the people without leaving anything behind. We will complete all the work before opening the terminal.

Selvi.Apoorva IAS., Principal Secretary of the Housing and Urban Development Department, Thiru. Ansul Mishra IAS, Member Secretary, Chennai Metropolitan Development Authority and along with the officials of the CMDA and other departments continued to discuss the work leading to the opening of Kilambakkam Bus Terminal on a daily basis. We are conducting inspection meetings and establishing newly required construction works. Therefore, Kilambakkam Bus Terminal will be constructed very soon within a certain period of time. This was said by the Honorable Minister.
