Today (15.5.2023) we visited the completed works of Kilambakkam New Suburban Bus Terminal and the review meeting was held with Tambaram City Police Commissioner, regarding to run the mufassil buses without traffic congestion on the G.S.T. road and setting up alternative routes for southern district buses at Kilambakkam New Suburban Bus Terminal. In this discussion, we have planned to construct a roundana at Guduvancheri, widening the road from Guduvancheri, Madambakkam road to Mannivakkam of about 7 km and from Kandigai to Guduvancheri of about 18 km road and from Nallampakkam to Urappakkam GST road of about 10 km.
