ORDER:

The draft Master Plan for the Madras Metropolitan Area, as prepared by the Madras Metropolitan Development Authority was notified for public information on 5.8.75, inviting objections and suggestions and information was also sent to all the Heads of Departments and constituent local bodies in the Madras Metropolitan Area. The objections and suggestions received were considered by a special committee of the Madras Metropolitan Development Authority and in the light of the suggestions made by the Committee, the Madras Metropolitan Development Authority has finalised the draft Master Plan and has forwarded it to the Government for approval as required under section 28 of the Tamil Nadu Town and Country Planning Act, 1971.

2. The Government constituted a Committee, in the Government Order second read above, to study the draft Master Plan as proposed by the Madras Metropolitan Development Authority and make its recommendation to the Government. The Committee has examined the draft Master Plan and has made certain suggestions for modifications in the Master Plan. As required under section 28 of the Act, the Director of Town and Country Planning has been consulted by the Government and he has accepted the suggestions of the Committee.

3. The Government accept the recommendation of the Committee and approve the draft Master Plan for the Madras Metropolitan Area, subject to the modifications suggested by the Committee.

4. The appended notification will be published in the next issue of the Tamil Nadu Government Gazette.
