Agenda Item No.48.02 Minutes of the 47th Meeting of the Monitoring Committee – Confirmation of the minutes and Action Taken Report – Subject placed before the Monitoring Committee

Minutes Recorded.

The non official members of the Monitoring Committee pointed out that the new Regularisation Scheme 2012 goes against the principles and cut off date set by the 2006 High Court order. The members felt that extending the cut off date from July 27, 1999 to July 1, 2007 is not sanctioned by the Court.

The Government, after notifying the scheme, has recently published the guidelines and rules to implement it. The members felt that this move clearly shows that the State Government and the CMDA have decided to go ahead with the regularisation despite the non-official members protesting against it.

The non official members further stated that a few days back, the CMDA had called for applications for regularisation under the 2012 scheme. The Committee members think that in this situation they cannot process the regularisation application under the 1999 scheme, which was the only scheme sanctioned by the High Court. The members felt that this move by the CMDA further violates not only the court order but also creates a big confusion on the ground and sends a wrong message about the Government's unwillingness to enforce the rules.

The non official members have decided to file a report in the High Court and seek direction from it.

The non official members took only one agenda for business. It processed an appeal application as directed by the Court and offered their remarks. They did not participate in other deliberations or processing of 22 appeal cases.

It was clearly indicated to the non official members that the Hon'ble High Court in its order dt.23.8.2006 have constituted the Monitoring Committee to oversee the process of 1999 Reg. Scheme. Further, it was explained that the newly inserted section 113-C of Town and Country Planning Act, though exempt any building developed on or before 01.07.2007, specific guidelines and rules have been notified for Exemption. It will not be a blanket relief to the violations but providing only limited solution to the development such as FSI violation not exceeding 50% of the allowable limit, setback violation not exceeding 50% and road width violation not exceeding 20%, subject to payment of GLV depending on the violations. The activity in the building shall be in conformity to the land use zoning and parking as per standards prescribed in the Development Control Rules existed as on 1.7.2007 or in the vicinity not exceeding a distance of 250 mtrs. from the site under reference and adequate fire safety measures. Further, it was explained that the Exemption under section 113-C will not interfere with the Reg. Scheme Applications 1999 and the Monitoring Committee can continue to function as per the directions of the Hon'ble High Court.
