Agenda Item 57.02	Minutes of the 56 th meeting of the Monitoring Committee – Confirmation of the minutes and Action taken report – subject placed before the Monitoring Committee.
Minutes	<p>With regard to the Action Taken Report on the Agenda of the last meeting of Monitoring Committee in item No.56.10, it was reported that the Secretary to Govt., Housing & Urban Development Dept. in his letter, dt.30.05.2016 has sought the remarks of CMDA regarding the Council Resolution passed by the Greater Chennai Corporation declaring the road width of Santhome High Road to be 18 m. which has to be widened to 24 m.</p> <p>The Members of the Monitoring Committee opined that once the Monitoring Committee has decided on the regularisability of Reg. application, then the decision of the Monitoring Committee is binding on the Govt. In response, the Vice-Chairman(i/c), CMDA stated that there is a window of appeal to the Govt. in the event of the applicant being aggrieved by the rejection order of CMDA even if the rejection order arises out of the decision of the Monitoring Committee. In this context, the Members of the Committee wanted clarification on the following points:-</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Whether Monitoring Committee is a Consultative or Decision making body ; 2. If Monitoring Committee is Deciding Body, then whether such decision can be over-ruled by the Govt. <p>After extensive discussion, Vice Chairman, CMDA as Convenor of the Monitoring Committee informed the members that the appellate powers of the Govt. are derived from an Act passed by the legislature and the same cannot be restricted by the decision of a committee. In any case, the principles of Natural justice also require a mechanism for appeal against the orders of the Monitoring Committee.</p> <p>As per the orders of the High Court, the recommendations of the Monitoring Committee regarding action on illegal Special and Multistoreyed buildings, the same is mandatory for CMDA and Greater Chennai Corporation, while in respect of dealing with Regularisation applications under Sec.113-(A) and 113-A (6) and changes in Master Plan & DCR, its role is consultative and guiding in nature.</p> <p>However, few of the members were not satisfied and requested to adjourn the meeting. The meeting was accordingly adjourned.</p>
