

**Announcements of Chennai Metropolitan Development Authority for the financial year 2023-24 all the work will be started soon in terms of implementation and to fulfil the demands of the MLA**

As per the direction of the Hon'ble Chief Minister of Tamil Nadu, to implement the announcements of CMDA for the financial year 2023-24, Hon'ble Minister cum Chairman for Chennai Metropolitan Development Authority and Minister for Hindu Religious and Charitable Endowments Thiru. P.K. Sekarbabu today (9.5.2023) inspected at Chennai, Annanagar West, 100 feet main road at an estimated cost of Rs.15 crore for the construction of a footbridge with moving escalators, for the development of a 4.5 acre municipal sports ground at Shenoy Nagar, Chennai at an estimated cost of Rs.5 crore, and for the, Chennai. In connection with the beautification of the banks of the 1.5 km long Puliur canal at Kodambakkam at an estimated cost of Rs.5 crore, he went directly to the places and conducted a field inspection.

**Hon'ble Minister cum Chairman for Chennai Metropolitan Development Authority and Minister for Hindu Religious and Charitable Endowments Thiru.P.K. Sekarbabu said:**

As directed by Hon'ble Chief Minister of Tamil Nadu, 50 Notifications for Chennai Metropolitan Development Corporation were announced in Tamil Nadu Legislative Assembly for the financial year 2023-24. In order to speed up the implementation of 34 notifications for the development of 26 assembly constituencies in Chennai metropolitan area, today (9.5.2023) a footbridge with moving electric escalators will be constructed near VR Mall, Annanagar West, 100 feet main road at an estimated cost of Rs.15 crore. The 4.5 acre Municipal Sports Ground at Shenoy Nagar, Chennai will be upgraded at a cost of Rs.5 crore. Similarly, the 1.5 kilometer Puliur long Canal canal in Kodambakkam, Chennai, will be completely cleared at an estimated cost of Rs. 5 crore to maintain and protect these areas from any flood damage during monsoons.

In the Budget year of 2023-24, a tourist exhibition at the Chennai Island grounds and a 5 km cycle lane on the East Coast Road as well as beach cleaning work were announced. In accordance with the order of the Hon'ble Chief Minister of Tamil Nadu to go to the field and inspect all the announcements, the field inspection has been carried out in 19 places in the 14 Assembly constituencies, and the remaining 15 places will be inspected very soon and the work will be started by the end of this year.

The Hon'ble Chief Minister of Tamil Nadu has ordered the Chennai Metropolitan Development Authority to develop the north Chennai area to the extent of 1000 crore rupees in three years with Greater Chennai Corporation, Chennai Water Supply and Sewerage Board and Metropolitan Transport Corporation. In that way, in order to strengthen the thoughts of the honorable Chief Minister in the city of Chennai, we are speeding up these development works by conducting a field inspection in one area every day and holding review meetings to coordinate and implement the work.

After the independence of India, the changes being made in the sports sector, the structures to be set up for the sports sector, as well as the projects to be carried out on behalf of the sports sector, the Honorable Minister of Youth Welfare and Sports Development, Mr. Udayanidhi Stalin, has made great efforts. As a result of this, structures are being improved to create a situation where Tamil Nadu will be the best state in the field of sports at the Union level in the coming times. This was said by the Honorable Minister.
